About the Club

General meetings are held on the second Tuesday of every month at the Canberra Club in the City, beginning at 8.00pm. All members and visitors are most welcome.

Members of the Canberra Fisherman's Club are eligible to set Club Records and, upon payment of an Australian National Sportfishing Association (ANSA) affiliation fee, also able to set Australian records and World records (through ANSA affiliation with the International Game Fishing Association (IGFA)).

Aims of the Club

- To promote sport fishing
- To foster the art of angling
- To teach the art of angling to new members and particularly juniors
- To promote the study and conservation of fish species and the environment
- To co-operate with and support other bodies with similar aims and ideals.

The Club also supports the *Recfish Australia National Code of Practice for Recreational and Sport Fishing*, which endorses:

1. Taking no more than our immediate needs
2. Understanding and observing all fishing regulations and reporting illegal fishing activities
3. Supporting and encouraging activities that restore and enhance fisheries and fish habitat
4. Preventing pollution and protecting wildlife by removing rubbish
5. Using established roads and tracks
6. Taking care when boating and anchoring to avoid damaging sensitive areas
7. Reporting environmental damage and pollution to the relevant authorities
8. Avoiding interactions with threatened species and their critical habitats
9. Quickly and correctly returning unwanted or illegal catches to the water
10. Using only legal tackle, attending our gear and valuing our catch
11. Practicing courtesy towards all those who use inland and coastal waters
12. Obtaining permission from landholders and traditional owners before entering land
13. Caring for our own safety and the safety of others when fishing

Recorder's Report

Hi All

We've had two Outings since the last newsletter so there is a bit to report.

Kalkite Outing – September

The Kalkite Outing was popular once again with 16 Members in attendance. There were 28 fish caught which included 15 Rainbow Trout, 11 Brown Trout, 1 Brook and 1 Atlantic Salmon.

The heaviest and highest pointscore fish of the weekend went to Tom Stanfield who landed a Brown Trout of **2.20kg on 1**, Chris Lemmon caught the best Rainbow Trout of **1.32kg on 1** (which was a Boardfish at the time), Andrew Butt caught the only Brook Trout of 1.19kg on 3, and I caught the Atlantic Salmon which was a long lean 0.48kg on 1.

Other kilo plus fish went to:

Tom Stanfield – Brown 1.39kg

Andrew Butt – Browns 1.80kg, 1.60kg, 1.50kg

Dave Walton – Brown 1.20kg

Steve Borkowskis – Brown 1.26kg

Glen Malam – Brown 1.57kg

So overall a successful Outing, with all 4 species caught over the weekend and plenty of Masters fish.

Talbingo Convention – October

Well we've just come back from another successful outing for the Club, taking out plenty of trophies in the ANSA section of the Comp:

- **Champion Club**
- **Senior Champion (Steve Borkowskis)**
- **Heaviest Trout Senior (Steve Borkowskis – Brown Trout 1.47kg)**
- **Junior Champion (Tom Stanfield)**
- **Heaviest Perch Junior (Tom Stanfield – Redfin 1.22kg)**

Overall there were about 65 fish weighed in by 200 something competitors so the fishing wasn't that easy as per usual but there were fish for those who persisted or were in the right place at the right time. In the Open section there were a fair few Golden Perch caught out of Blowering compared to previous years, averaging 2-3kg with a few up around the 4-5kg mark. The best Redfin was about 1.60kg, best Brown 2.00kg, and best Rainbow 1.30kg.

Our seven Club Members caught 5 Redfin, 4 Brown Trout and 3 Rainbow Trout (Including All Tackle Captures).

Other Captures

Chris and Colin Clark did some beach fishing in late September and Colin landed a Common Shovel-nosed Ray of 3.75kg on 2. They reported that all the beaches were pretty flat at the time, so fishing was a little quiet.

Steve Bailey caught a Redfin of 1.20kg on 1 at Secret Lake to add to his Landbased Sportfishing Masters.

Tom and Jamie Stanfield fished Jindabyne and Tom caught a Rainbow Trout of 1.40kg on 1. Nice work Tom that's a good one.

The McGovern's also fished Jindabyne, Kelsey caught a Rainbow Trout of 1.47kg on 2, and Mitchell caught a Brown of 1.56kg on 3, and a Rainbow of 1.16kg. Good to see the juniors catching some quality fish. Andrew also reported losing a 2kg plus Rainbow spinning in one of the rivers (don't tell the Rat!)

Brian Stacy caught a couple of legal Flathead in the Clyde to put himself in the running for the Flathead total length trophy; he also caught a Leatherjacket of 0.58kg off Durras.

Ashley Barber caught several Golden Perch from various locations including fish of 580mm, 550mm, 530mm, 520mm, 430mm, and 420mm. This puts Ashley miles out in front of the Golden Perch total length trophy. Perhaps some of us might need to dust off the native's gear and see if we can give him a little competition.

Since the last newsletter I've been out after Carp and have landed some decent ones, the best going 8.40kg from Ginninderra, and another of 7.34kg from Tuggeranong, as well as plenty of others above 5kg. I'm in the process of setting up with some proper heavy tackle to see if I can stop some of the larger ones that have been consistently smoking me on 2kg braid.

I'll see some of you at Burrinjuck, otherwise good luck over the next month hope you catch some fish.

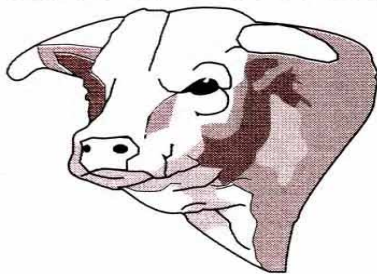

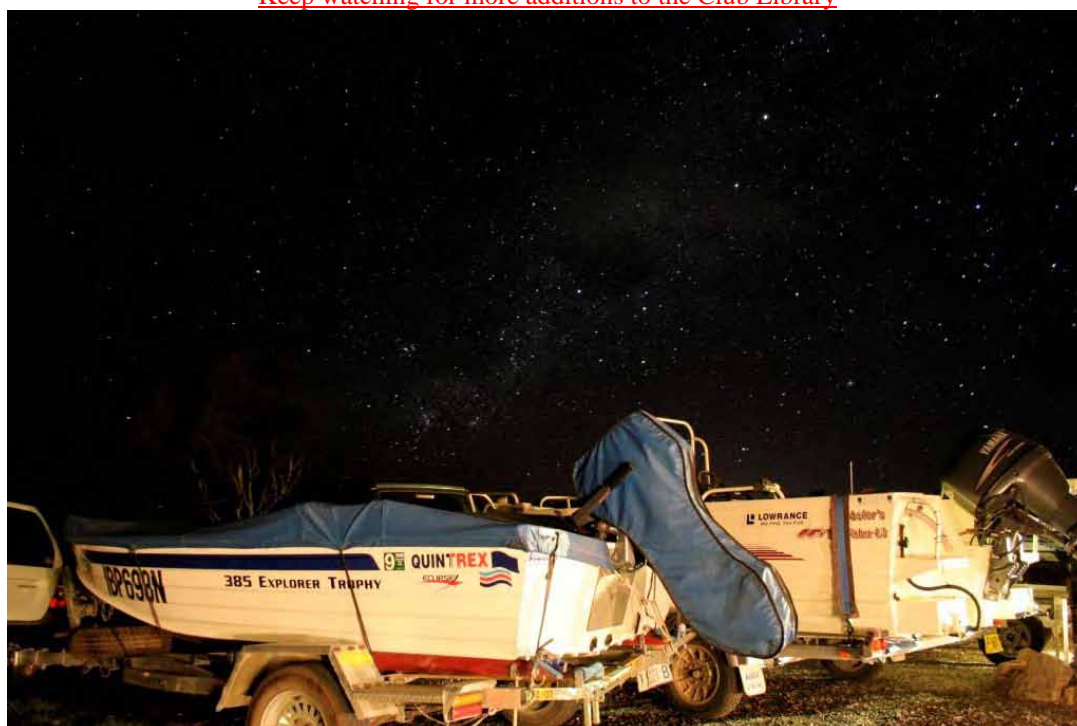
